The Kerala Economic Association (KEA), started in 2013, endeavours to provide a common platform for students, researchers, teachers, administrators, industrialists and others who are interested in the disciplinary domain of economics in general and the dynamics of the regional economy of Kerala in particular. Kerala's unique path to economic development has received international acclaim. The development experience of Kerala is widely praised as a pinnacle of social progress and welfare-centric policies. While most Indian states struggle with social indicators, Kerala has notably elevated living standards for its people. Over the decades, the state has consistently invested in building social infrastructure, especially education, health, and social protection. Nevertheless, the state's development experience has not been free of blemishes. It attracted criticism on account of the exclusion of several outlier groups such as women, people belonging to scheduled castes and scheduled tribes, fisher folk, etc. Critics have also pointed out the question of the model's sustainability on account of fiscal and environmental limits.

Recent global, national and regional developments necessitate a revisit of both the strengths and weaknesses of the state's economy. Centralization of the fiscal system and the consequent shrinking of the fiscal space, climate change, growth in inequality on account of globalization, high rates of educated unemployment of the youth, especially among women, population aging and related issues of geriatric care, growing incidents of human-animal conflicts, rehabilitation of return migrants, infrastructure deficit, etc. are significant in the current context. The Kerala Economic Conference 2025 seeks to address some of these issues.

The conference will be inaugurated by Hon'ble Chief Minister of Kerala. It will bring together a galaxy of eminent scholars from within and outside Kerala. Plenary session will be organised in honour of K.N. Raj, M. Kunhaman, K.K. Subramanian and K K George.
